

September 2005 – Joint IDA-AGC Consultation Paper on Proposed Spam Control Bill

The Attorney-General's Chambers of Singapore and Infocomm Development Authority of Singapore have issued a second public consultation paper on the proposed Spam Control Bill. The first public consultation was conducted in May 2004 to seek feedback on the Proposed Legislative Framework for the Control of E-mail Spam. This second consultation exercise seeks views on the draft Spam Control Bill for Singapore, which includes mobile spam and proposes that civil rights and remedies be granted to any person who suffers loss or damage from non-compliant spam. Consultation was closed on 12 October 2005.
